

NOTICE OF CONDITIONAL ACCEPTANCE OF OFFER AND RE-DRAFT

I conditionally accept your offer to answer your questions, provide my personal and private information to you and/or conduct a search of my private property upon **proof of claim** of all the following important and relevant points of Law:

- 1) That your Principal(s) were not lawfully served my Claim of Right and Fee Schedule (hereafter conjointly "Claim of Right") which unequivocally states the penalty for unlawful infractions caused by Police Officers without my expressed written consent; and,
- 2) That in the absence of any evidence that I have breached the peace, that I am lawfully obligated to provide details to you concerning my private property, private details or information and/or answer questions posed by you; and,
- 3) That by you attempting to enforce any directives from your principal(s) **upon me** that you cannot be held fully personally liable for infringing upon my Common Law rights, Commercial Law rights and Constitutional rights, in accordance with the Nuremberg Findings (following orders is no excuse); and,
- 4) That as a man trading as a Police Officer in a Common law jurisdiction, you are NOT responsible and liable for your actions and thus directly answerable and liable to any Civil law claims howsoever arising; and,
- 5) That you do not have a duty of care and an obligation to obey and be cognisant of lawfully served notices; and,
- 6) That ignorance of the Law is a fair and reasonable excuse for breaking the Law; and,
- 7) That you are NOT ignorant of the law and are NOT ignorant of the lawfully served notices upon your principals; and,
- 8) That the Claim of Right served upon your Principal(s) does **not** apply to you and that the Claim of Right evidenced in the Australian Criminal Code Act 1995 has been lawfully removed; and,
- 9) That your laws state such lawful removal clearly, specifically and unequivocally through lawfully enacted legislation; and,
- 10) That it is not now a fact that my Claim of Right served on your Principal(s) is **not** now clearly and lawfully established with certainty via estoppel by acquiescence; and,
- 11) That as a Police Officer in a Common Law jurisdiction you do **not** have to follow clearly established Law; and,
- 12) That you can **not** be held personally liable under your own commercial liability for infractions of the very law you serve;
- 13) That notice to agent is notice to principal and notice to principal is notice to agent does **not** apply in Australian and International Law; and,
- 14) That you are **not** employed as a Peace Officer to enforce the peace; and,
- 15) That any action you now proceed with that damages me is **not** evidence of a clear breach of the peace, notwithstanding that you have a duty and obligation to maintain the peace; and,
- 16) That I did breach the peace, and that you personally witnessed and attest that I breached the peace; and,
- 17) That in the absence of any action by me to breach the peace, that any action you now cause to damage me is **not** an act of aggression and a breach of the very peace you are duty bound to maintain.

Officer, you understand you have now been **SERVED** and put on **NOTICE** with this lawful and binding NOTICE of Conditional Acceptance of your offer. If you have any questions or doubts, you are hereby lawfully re-drafted and directed to seek clear, complete, competent and concise direction from your Principal(s). Failure to do so is a clear indication that you now accept FULL COMMERCIAL LIABILITY for any actions you now undertake while acting as a Police Officer. Failure to now read/accept this lawful notice and you attempt to transgress upon me clearly indicates that you act in dishonour and you accept the consequences of that dishonour. Please now act with caution and conduct and govern yourself accordingly.

Police at Roadside

You: 'Hello, how can I help you?'

Police: 'Can I see your licence?'

Y: 'Hear – you'll need to read this & check with your superiors...' – hand over the Conditional Acceptance. He will radio through to his superior & check out. This should enable you to continue travelling – but with a warning not to do whatever it is that attracted them. If not...

P: 'Could you step out of the car?' or whatever...

Y: 'Aren't you a peace officer?'

P: Either NO ANSWER, or 'I'm a police officer' or 'I need your licence' or 'step out of the car'

Y: 'Did you observe me breaching the peace?'

P: No, but you were...'

Y: 'No no, don't worry about that, so you didn't observe me breaching the peace?'

P: 'No, but you were speeding' or whatever

Y: 'So you admit I didn't breach the peace, am I free to go?'

P: 'No, I want your licence' or 'step out of the car'

Y: 'Am I being detained?'

P: 'No, where is your licence?'

Y: 'What is your reasonable excuse?'

P: 'You were speeding' or whatever

Y: 'My apologies & I will not do that again, however that's not breaching the peace, & as you have already declared, I have not breached the peace, am I now free to go?'

P: 'No, I want your licence' or 'step out of the car'

Y: 'Am I being detained?'

P: 'No, I want your licence'

Y: 'Am I free to go, I don't wish to do business with you'

P: 'No, step out of the car. Are you refusing to follow my directions?'

Y: SMILE & say 'Am I free to go sir?'

P: 'Step out of the car'

Y: 'Just sign the agreement so I can hold you liable for all damages you intend causing me. I am recording this incident and the recording WILL BE USED AGAINST YOU'

(He will check again with a superior as now he has been noticed twice re: your non consent to do business. They now bear liability. Aggravated assault is a serious charge. You will be directed to move on)

P: 'Sir, you'll need to slow down – you may go'

Y: 'Thank you Sir, have a good afternoon ...'
