

A) Example of how you fill in all future tax returns for Business Returns, Partnerships, Self Employed

The form asks the filler to enter block letter name, that's the vessel-person-agent in commerce and it doesn't earn anything, not a cracker, because its dead! Fred!

It's the living man that extends his energy in EXCHANGE for consideration/value in this case money of exchange but you're not asked for what YOU have earned/benefited, the agent in commerce is asked to volunteer what IT earned for the year, so people must learn to provide precisely what is being asked, thereby avoid committing perjury, by virtue they sign to something which wasn't true, very dangerous.... The tax office doesn't pursue a perjury charge against you because the office is gaining an unjust gain from your unwitting voluntary contribution as well as committing you to enslave yourself under a heavy tax obligation. The Commissioner must be laughing himself silly under his breath!

Because the agent in commerce, your legal name, is collecting money for you in its bank account, (check the spelling on your bank account if you don't believe me. It will be capitalised because YOU, as a man, cannot be engaged in commerce) it could legitimately get some compensation, say \$500 for the year for collecting in its bank account your hard earned credits from the fruits of your labour, so you pay it \$500 which is declared on the tax return and is well under the tax threshold so it and you don't pay any tax. Consequently whatever tax was collected will be returned to you.

Just remember to put for job description of your legal name, 'agent in commerce'

Re: your partnership, its the same thing so use both names as agents in commerce, still earn \$500 for the year, and when you sign off, just put

B) PAYE/G

Fill in the return as per Page 113 – Page 118

The key is to provide a sufficient expense that will bring your total expenses to below the current tax threshold (\$14,000) so that all tax with-held will be returned to you. Do NOT provide a contact phone number so that if the tax office needs to contact you, then it's employee must contact you in writing which permits you the time to THINK a reply to any of their questions, rather than being caught off guard on the telephone. If you are asked why you have such a high work related expenses, you can say that the Foundation that conducts work for MR/MRS NAME, issues an appropriate invoice, the funds remitted with which enable the living soul commonly called 'First Name' of the family 'Last Name' to live. It is true, isn't it, that neither a private Foundation, a NON GOVERNEMENT NOT FOR PROFIT ORGANISATION is tax free as is the living soul, is that not true?

The key is to be prepared because the only defensive manoeuvre the ATO have is to attack & NOT directly answer any question, which the answer would incriminate THEM. So BE PREPARED should you receive a letter from the ATO asking for various proof of claims.

Answer any questions with a question. 'Is an NGO & Not For Profit Organisation required to provide its private information or to pay tax? NOOOOOO!

Footnote:

Early 2010 the tax office took notice of this process for PAYE/G. It now audits some people using this technique. Use your own discretion. It is now suggested that the amount entered in the 'other expenses' be only gradually raised each year so as not to trigger an audit. Better still, create a part time cash flow business and develop a position of financial independence.
